CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE


A representation proceeding having been conducted in the above matter by the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in accordance with RSA 273-A, Section 10 and the Rules and Regulations of the Board and it appearing that a negotiating representative has been selected.

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, and after the conduct of a representation election, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the UAW PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE NASHUA POLICE DEPARTMENT has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named Public Employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for the purpose of collective negotiations and the settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All full and part-time professional, technical and supervisory civilians excluding: Parking Enforcement Specialists, Animal Control Officers, Communications Div. Union Personnel, Non-Supervisory and Professional Teamsters Union Personnel, part-time clerical and per diem civilians.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named Public Employer shall negotiate collectively with the UAW PROFESSIONAL EMPLOYEES OF THE NASHUA POLICE DEPARTMENT with an objective to reaching an agreement with the employee organization on terms and conditions of employment, and shall negotiate collectively with such employee organization in the determination, and administration of, grievances.
