CONSENT DECREE


The parties, appearing at the PELRB's offices in Concord, New Hampshire on July 19, 2004, announced the following joint stipulation in full resolution and settlement of the pending unfair labor practice complaint:

1. In accordance with the provisions of RSA 273-A, the Union is entitled to information from the City that is reasonable and necessary in the performance of its role as the exclusive representative of the certified bargaining unit, including, but not limited to, information regarding and pertaining to the rank, wages and benefit accrual rates of bargaining unit members.
2. The City of Claremont, while making no admission of any violation of RSA 273-A, agrees to provide such information to the Union within a reasonable period of time following a request for same.
3. The parties further agree that this consent decree may be enforced by an appropriate filing with the PELRB.

Upon review of this agreement, it is determined that its provisions are in the best interests of the parties and supportive of the collective bargaining process contemplated by RSA 273-A. Accordingly, the PELRB hereby adopts the provisions of the agreement as and for its order in this case and directs that the underlying unfair labor practice complaint be DISMISSED in accordance therewith.
