2004 SYNOPSIS

City of Portsmouth v. AFSCME Council 93, Local 1386, Portsmouth City Employees PELRB Case No. A-0411-41

City claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by demanding arbitration of grievances after time limit for submitting them to arbitration expired. PELRB ordered union to withdraw its demands to arbitrate grievances finding that contractual time limit to demand arbitration lapsed by substantial number of days before union filed its demands without any proof of extension granted by the city.
