ORDER

WHEREAS, a pre-hearing conference was convened on August 19, 2005 in Case No. F-0118-15 before the undersigned hearing officer, and, also on said date, the Town of Hampton ("the Town") filed a "counter" complaint against the Hampton Firefighters Local 2664, IAFF ("the Association"), resulting in Case No: F-0118-16, and

WHEREAS, during the course of the pre-hearing conference, the Town and Association indicated their joint request to the hearing officer (1) that the instant matters be consolidated, (2) that they be stayed pending the Board's decision in the consolidated matters of Hampton Fire Department Supervisory Association, Local 3017, IAFF v. Town of Hampton (Case No: F-0127-7) and Town of Hampton v. Hampton Fire Department Supervisory Association, Local 3017, IAFF (Case No: F-0127-8), and subsequently filed an "Assented to Motion to Consolidate and Stay Proceedings" on August 24, 2005, it is hereby:

ORDERED that (1) the instant matters are consolidated based upon the common nucleus of operative facts arising out of both claims, (2) these proceedings, including the filing deadline for any responsive pleading(s), are stayed, pending the Board's decision in PELRB Case Nos: F-

0127-7 and F-0127-8, and (3) unless either party files a request for further proceedings before the PELRB within thirty (30) days of the issuance of the Board's decision in PELRB Case Nos: F-0127-7 and F-0127-8, these matters shall be administratively dismissed.
