## ORDER ON MOTION FOR ENFORCEMENT

The Public Employee Labor Relations Board (Board) conferred for the purpose of considering the Complainant's Motion for Enforcement and took the following actions:

- 1. It reviewed the New Hampshire Trooper Association's Motion for Enforcement Pursuant to RSA 273-A:7 filed on August 25, 2005 and the Respondent's Objection to New Hampshire Troopers Association's Motion for Enforcement Pursuant to RSA 273-A filed on September 9, 2005.
- 2. It re-examined the record in this matter, including the Complainant's unfair labor practice complaint, the Respondent's answer in response thereto, and the other filings of the parties in this matter.
- 3. It reviewed Decision No. 2005-028, issued in this matter on March 16, 2005, and Decision No. 2005-056, issued on April 27, 2005.

4. It DENIED the New Hampshire Trooper Association's Motion for Enforcement Pursuant to RSA 273-A:7, noting that this matter is presently on appeal before the Supreme Court and that in the event the Court affirms the Board's decision, the make whole remedy being sought by the Association would be ascertainable and payable at that time.
