ORDER

WHEREAS a pre-hearing conference in these matters was convened on October 12, 2005 before the undersigned hearing officer; and,

WHEREAS, during the course of the pre-hearing conference, the parties signed a memorandum of agreement memorializing certain stipulations, including, but not limited to, the PELRB's formal consolidation of the instant matters and a continuance of the PELRB's October 25, 2005 hearing in consideration of the parties' engagement in specified settlement efforts; it is hereby:

ORDERED that (1) PELRB Case No. M-0680-4 and PELRB Case No. T-0233-17 are consolidated; (2) the PELRB hearing scheduled for October 25, 2005 is cancelled and the instant matters shall stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until January 10, 2006; (3) the School Board and Local 2348 shall meet on October 25, 2005 to discuss contract negotiations,

including, but not limited to, the subject matter of the instant pending unfair labor practice charge, and the parties shall utilize their best efforts to reach a settlement; (4) the School Board and Local 6219 shall consider meeting, on a date to be determined, in order to discuss the status of contract negotiations, including, but not limited to, the subject matter of the instant pending unfair labor practice charge, they shall utilize their best efforts to reach a settlement, and their counsel shall report to the PELRB as to the date of any such meeting by 11/2/05; (5) these matters shall stand continued on the PELRB's docket of cases until January 10, 2006 and unless any party to these proceedings requests on or before said date that the PELRB hearing be rescheduled, these matters shall thereafter be administratively dismissed.
