ORDER ON PARTIES' MOTION TO CONTINUE


The Board is in receipt of a joint written motion submitted by the parties to continue the conduct of the scheduled hearing on the merits of the complainants' charge against the respondent of improper labor practices. 1. The joint motion for a continuance of the hearing scheduled for October 20, 2005 is granted with the following conditions;
 - a. The matter is continued until such time as either party shall file a request that the hearing be rescheduled.
 - b. In the event that a request to reschedule this hearing is not filed with the PELRB by either party on or before January 2, 2006, the matter shall be administratively dismissed, with prejudice, as to the causes of action contained within the instant complaint.
