## 2005 SYNOPSIS

Sanborn Regional School District v. Sanborn Regional Education Association/ NEA-NH PELRB Case No. T-0256-23

District claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by demanding arbitration of grievance resulting from teacher's non-renewal. PELRB dismissed district's complaint and directed parties to proceed to arbitration finding that collective bargaining agreement (CBA) contained arbitration clause and that subject of dispute was not excluded from arbitration under CBA.
