
CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act, (RSA 273-A) and in accordance RSA 273-A:10 and Pub 303, IT IS HEREBY CERTIFIED that the Teamsters Local 633 of NH/Manchester School District, Directors and Coordinators, has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All Directors and Coordinators employed by the City of Manchester School District SAU 37 in the Following positions: Attendance Coordinator, Director of School Food & Nutrition Services, Senior Accountant, Assistant Director of Student Services, Special Education Coordinator, Transportation Coordinator, IT Help Desk Coordinator, Athletic Director, District Grant Writer, Fine Arts Director, Medicaid Coordinator, School/Community Service Coordinator, Court Liason, Federal Projects Director, Director of Alternative Education, Coordinator of the Deaf & Hard of Hearing, Facilitator of Project Lead the Way. **EXCLUDED:** 21st Century Director, Accounting Manager, Assistant Superintendents, Superintendent. **EXCLUDED CONFIDENTIAL:** Benefits Coordinator, Assistant Business Administrator, Human Resources Coordinator, Director of Information Technology, Payroll Supervisor, Human Resource Director, Chief Financial Officer.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
