ORDER ON PARTIES' MOTIONS FOR RECONSIDERATION


The Public Employee Labor Relations Board ("PELRB") conferred for the purpose of considering the "Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration" filed on June 13, 2006, the Complainant's "Motion for Reconsideration" filed on June 21, 2006, the Complainant's "Objection to the Respondent's Motion for Reconsideration" filed on June 22, 2006, the "Respondent's Objection to Complainant's Motion for Reconsideration" filed on June 30, 2006, the Complainant's "Reply to Respondent's Objection to Complainant's Motion for Reconsideration" filed on July 10, 2006, and took the following actions:

1. Pursuant to RSA 541 and N.H. Admin R. Pub 205, it reviewed the parties' cross-motions for reconsideration and subsequent responsive filings.
2. It examined the previous decision issued in this matter, specifically PELRB Decision No. 2006-090 (dated June 6, 2006). It noted that the record in this matter was closed on May 3, 2006.
3. It reviewed the previous filings of the parties, including the Complaint, the Answer, and their respective memorandums of law.

4. It DENIED the parties' Motions for Reconsideration.
