## ORDER RE: STATE EMPLOYEES' ASSOCIATION OF NEW HAMPSHIRE INC., SEIU LOCAL 1984'S MOTION TO COMPLY WITH FORTYFIVE DAY ADJUDICATORY HEARING REQUIREMENT

On September 19, 2006 the State Employees' Association of New Hampshire, SEIU Local 1984, (hereinafter the "SEA") filed a "Motion to Comply with Forty-Five Day Adjudicatory Hearing Requirement." A copy of the SEA electronic filing is attached.

This matter is presently scheduled for informal pre-hearing conference on September 29, 2006 and hearing on October 12, 2006. It was previously scheduled for informal pre-hearing conference on August 24, 2006 but at the outset of that conference a request to continue the conference was made and all parties agreed to the continuation and the September 29, 2006 date was thereafter established with the parties' involvement. The October 12, 2006 hearing date has remained unchanged since the August 18, 2006 scheduling notice issued.

The PELRB finds that the circumstances of the case require shortening the 15 day objection period so that this case can proceed in a timely, orderly, and efficient manner and in particular so that the SEA's request to change the hearing date is addressed as soon as practicable. Accordingly, pursuant to Pub 203.03(c) any objections to the SEA's request to move the October 12, 2006 hearing date only shall be filed on or before September 20, 2006. The

deadline for objecting to all other aspects of the SEA's motion is not modified or changed by virtue of this order.
