
ORDER ON MOTION TO CONTINUE

The parties appeared on May 4, 2007 for a hearing pursuant to the board's July 31, 2006 Order on Motion for Rehearing, Decision No. 2006-111. This hearing had been scheduled and rescheduled a number of times for various reasons. At the outset of the hearing the parties were informed that the board did not find it necessary for the parties to resubmit, via testimony, the evidence submitted at the hearing giving rise to the underlying hearing officer decision about which the Town of Milford complains. The parties were informed that the board has the record from the earlier proceeding and can review the testimony and exhibits from the earlier proceeding on that basis. The board then heard any objections or arguments the parties wished to make on this issue. Ultimately the parties jointly requested a continuance as they had not anticipated proceeding in the manner outlined by the board. The board granted the motion to continue and also agreed to provide the parties with the opportunity, in advance of a rescheduled hearing, to make filings with the board addressing how they contend the rescheduled hearing should proceed and be conducted.

Accordingly, on or before June 4, 2007 the parties are to make their filings, if any, concerning how they contend the rescheduled hearing should proceed and be conducted. The board will then schedule a new hearing date and also address the manner in which the hearing will be conducted.

It is so ordered.
