

ORDER ON MOTION TO CONTINUE

On August 13, 2007 the petitioner filed an assented to motion to continue on account of 1) its failure to docket the August 16, 2007 hearing date contained in the May 30, 2007 pre-hearing order and the resulting scheduling conflicts for counsel; and 2) the parties' expectations that an agreed upon resolution in this matter will be reached. In the circumstances, and anticipating that in fact this matter will ultimately resolve by agreement based on the parties' representations, the motion to continue is granted. There will be no further proceedings scheduled in this case for the next 60 days. At the end of 60 days this matter will be administratively dismissed with prejudice unless, before the expiration of the 60-day period, the PELRB receives a request to schedule a further hearing based upon the parties' failure to resolve the matter by agreement.
