2007 SYNOPSIS

Hollis/Brookline Cooperative School Board v. Hollis Education Association/NEA-NH PELRB Case No. E-0073-1

School board claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by improperly demanding arbitration. PELRB ordered union to refrain from further demands for arbitration finding that union's current grievance was same as its first one and that first grievance was terminated because violation, which was subject of first grievance, was single act, and not continuing violation, despite its continuing effects.
