

2007 SYNOPSIS

Pittsfield School District v. Education Association of Pittsfield, NEA-NH PELRB Case No. E-0024-2

District claimed that union committed unfair labor practice by seeking arbitration of grievances on retroactive pay calculations and seeking more funds than district approved when current contract was ratified. PELRB denied district's complaint finding that dispute was arbitrable and that union did not seek to exceed undisputed cost item but claimed that amount was sufficient to fund step increase. PELRB held that arbitration proceeding was subject to relevant and approved cost item.
