



further pre-hearing conference and an adjudicative hearing on the ground that the parties had not been able to finalize the settlement documentation.

On January 8, 2010 the parties' representatives attended a pre-hearing conference at the PELRB offices in Concord. The parties agreed to continue settlement discussions and agreed to meet and exchange settlement proposals.

#### DECISION

1. "Parties" means the named complainant and respondent or the counsel/representative appearing in the case.
2. The parties shall exchange settlement proposals before **January 12, 2010**.
3. The parties' shall meet on **January 13, 2010** at the PELRB offices in Concord, following the completion of the pre-hearing conference in Case No. G-0097-6, and shall engage in settlement discussion in an effort to resolve the dispute in the above captioned matter. The parties' representatives shall be prepared for a serious and meaningful discussion of possible agreed upon resolutions of the dispute and shall have authority to engage in such discussion. The complaining party shall inform the PELRB of any settlement of the pending issues immediately. In the absence of communication from the complaining party indicating that it withdraws the complaint, the following schedule will apply.
4. The parties shall file a Statement of Stipulated Facts no later than **January 14, 2010**.
5. The parties shall amend, exchange, and file their Witness and Exhibit lists no later than **January 14, 2010**.
6. The parties shall pre-mark any exhibits prior to the time of hearing and have sufficient copies available for distribution at the hearing as required by Pub 203.03.

## HEARINGS

Unless otherwise ordered as a result of the filing of a motion to continue or other motion, the adjudicatory hearing between the parties will be held on **January 22, 2010 at 9:00 AM** at the offices of the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in Concord. The time set aside for this hearing is 5 hours. If either party believes that additional time is required, written notice of the need for additional time shall be filed with the PELRB at least **7 days** prior to the date of hearing.
