PRE-HEARING MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

Background:

International Brotherhood of Teamsters, Local 633/Plaistow Police (Union) filed an unfair labor practice complaint against the Town of Plaistow (Town) on January 8, 2010. The Union claims that the Town violated RSA 273-A:5 by failing to bargain in good faith, to meet regularly for negotiations, and to respond to the Union's proposals. The Union requests the PELRB to order the Town to bargain in good faith. On January 14, 2010 the Town filed an answer denying the charge.

With the parties' agreement, the pre-hearing conference was conducted over the telephone on February 8, 2010.

DECISION

1. "Parties" means the named complainant and respondent or the counsel/representative appearing in the case.

2. The adjudicatory hearing scheduled for February 18, 2010 is hereby rescheduled for **March 17, 2010**. The rescheduling notice will be issued.
3. On or before **February 24, 2010** the Complainant shall file Supplemental Details of the Charge(s) setting out the facts giving rise to the complaint, including the date, time and place of the occurrence, and the names of all persons involved in or witnessing the occurrence, characterizing each particular act in terms of the specific provisions of RSA 273-A:5 alleged to have been violated. See Pub 201.02 (b).
4. The parties shall prepare and file a Statement of Stipulated Facts no later than **March 8, 2010**.
5. The parties shall amend, exchange, and file their Witness and Exhibit Lists no later than **March 8, 2010**.
6. The parties shall pre-mark any exhibits prior to the time of hearing and have sufficient copies available for distribution at the hearing as required by Pub 203.03.

HEARING

Unless otherwise ordered as a result of the filing of a motion to continue or other motion, the adjudicatory hearing between the parties will be held on **March 17, 2010 at 9:00 AM** at the offices of the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in Concord. The time set aside for this hearing is 5 hours. If either party believes that additional time is required, written notice of the need for additional time shall be filed with the PELRB **at least 7 days prior** to the date of hearing.
