**ORDER**

On November 8, 2010 the Pelham Police, Fire & Supervisors Association filed a petition for decertification requesting an election to determine whether the Association should be decertified as the exclusive representative of the following bargaining unit: Police Chief, Fire Chief, Assessor, Cable Coordinator, Cemetery Superintendent, Highway Agent, Transfer Station Superintendent, Parks and Recreation Director, Planning Director, and Senior Citizens Director. See PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate, Case No. M-0776, issued January 16, 2001. The petition for decertification is supported by authorization cards from at least 30% of the employees in the bargaining unit. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards, issued November 9, 2010. Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on November 8, 2010 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than November 23, 2010. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed within the specified time period. Accordingly, the Association's request for a secret ballot election to resolve the question of decertification is

granted. An Order for Election shall be issued and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled forthwith.
