CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2010-227 granting the petition for modification filed by the Nottingham Education Association/NEA-NH, the existing certification set forth in Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate issued by the PELRB on September 28, 1988 in Case No. T-0385 is amended; and it is hereby certified that the Nottingham Education Association/NEA-NH is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All Full-Time and Part-Time Teachers, Guidance Counselors, Library/Media Specialists, Nurses, and Speech/Language Pathologists within the Nottingham School District.

Further, it is ordered that the above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
