
Report and Order re: Confidential Inspection of Written Majority Authorization Cards

On February 8, 2011 the undersigned inspected and examined the confidential authorization cards at the PELRB offices in Concord in accordance with the procedures and requirements set forth in Pub 301.05 with the following result: There is an insufficient number of cards to establish a written majority authorization in the proposed bargaining unit based upon the amended employee list filed on February 2, 2011. There are sufficient authorization cards to establish the 30% interest necessary to request a secret ballot representation election.

A hearing is currently scheduled for February 9, 2011 to address the objections filed by the CCSNH. The parties shall appear as scheduled ready to proceed. However, unless at or before the start of the hearing the SEA files a written request for a secret ballot election to resolve the question of representation of any bargaining unit approved as a result of hearing this case shall be dismissed.
