**ORDER**

The New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a written majority authorization petition seeking to become the certified exclusive representative of certain employees of the Town of Farmington Police Department. The parties now agree to the following bargaining unit composition:

Unit: All positions employed by the Town of Farmington Police Department with the rank of Sergeant and Patrol Officer


Excluded: Secretary and Animal Control Officer

The parties' unit composition agreement is approved.

On February 18, 2011 the undersigned further inspected and examined the written majority authorization cards with the following result: there is a sufficient number of confidential authorization cards to establish, pursuant to the RSA 273-A:10, IX written majority authorization process, that a majority of the employees in the approved bargaining unit have selected the NEPBA as their exclusive representative. Accordingly, the NEPBA's petition is granted. The Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate shall issue forthwith.
