ORDER

The AFSCME Local 2301/Seabrook Supervisory Employees Association filed an agreed upon petition for modification on March 21, 2011 seeking to add the positions of Computer Systems Administrator and Water Department Chief Operator to the existing bargaining unit. See PELRB Decision No. 2003-011. Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on March 22, 2011 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than April 6, 2011. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed within the specified time period. Accordingly, the Association's petition for modification is hereby granted.
