ORDER

On October 14, 2011 the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to determine an exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit currently represented by the Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire, Newmarket Police Association. The subject bargaining unit contains following positions: all full time Patrolmen, Detectives, Master Detectives, Sergeants, Dispatchers, and permanent part time Dispatchers employed by the Newmarket Police Department. See PELRB Decision No. 2005-020. The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (October 18, 2011).

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on October 17, 2011 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and petitions to intervene were due no later than November 1, 2011. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed within the specified time period. Accordingly, the NEPBA's request for a secret ballot election to resolve the

question of representation is granted. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled in accordance with Pub 303.02.
