CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2012-057 granting the Association's petition for modification, the existing certification set forth in PELRB Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate (issued October 10, 1994, Case No. P-0751) is amended; and it is hereby certified that the Dover Police Administrators Association is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All supervisory personnel, including the Secretary to the Chief of Police, i.e., Executive Secretary to the Chief of Police, Captains, Sergeants, Supervisors, Personnel Assistant, Lieutenants, Police Prosecutor/Legal Advisor, Prosecutor, Records Supervisor, Communications Supervisor, Information Management Systems Administrator, and Parking Manager.

Further, it is ordered that the above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
