The AFSCME Local 2301/Seabrook Supervisory Employees Association filed an agreed upon petition for modification on May 11, 2012 seeking, among other things, to add the position of Deputy Tax Collector to the existing bargaining unit. See PELRB Decision No. 2011-101.
