
Order

On June 27, 2012 the New England Police Benevolent Association filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent a bargaining unit consisting of the following positions within the Town of Newmarket Police Department: Sergeant, Patrolman, Communication Supervisor, and Dispatcher. Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on June 27, 2012 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than July 12, 2012. No objections, exceptions or petitions to intervene have been filed. The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (July 11, 2012). All of the positions in the proposed bargaining unit were included in the bargaining unit that was certified by the PELRB in 2005 and represented by the Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire (Teamsters). See PELRB Decision No. 2005-020. The Teamsters surrendered its certification as exclusive representative of this bargaining unit in accordance with Pub 301.03 (j). See PELRB Decision 2012-135 (June 13, 2012).

Accordingly, the proposed bargaining unit is approved. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled in accordance with Pub 303.02.
