CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and a secret ballot election having been conducted in accordance with RSA 273-A:10, as reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2012-177, it is hereby certified that the New England Police Benevolent Association, Auburn Police Union has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.


UNIT: All Police Officers (Full-time and Part-time) and Sergeants (Full-time and Part-time) employed by the Town of Auburn Police Department.

EXCLUDED: Chief of Police, Captain, Lieutenant, Dispatcher, and Office Manager employed by the Town of Auburn Police Department.

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
