Background:

The complaint in this case was filed on October 13, 2010 and the first pre-hearing conference was held on December 1, 2010. See Pre-Hearing Memorandum and Order, PELRB Decision No. 2010-230. Thereafter, per the parties' requests, the proceedings in this case were continued pending the resolution of the related cases by the New Hampshire Personnel Appeals Board.

The parties appeared for the second pre-hearing conference in this case on September 26, 2012. At the pre-hearing conference, the parties informed the PELRB that they have resolved several issues set forth in the complaint and are working toward a settlement that would resolve the dispute in this case.

DECISION


1. "Parties" means the SEA, the DHHS, or their counsel/representative appearing in the case. The parties shall simultaneously copy each other electronically on all filings submitted in these proceedings.
2. The parties shall file their final witness and exhibit lists and a statement of stipulated facts no later than **October 15, 2012**.
3. The parties shall pre-mark exhibits by placing identifying markers in the upper right corner of each exhibit, if possible. To facilitate access to a particular exhibit, the parties shall use tabs to separate exhibits.
4. The parties shall promptly inform the PELRB of any resolution of this case in the interim.

HEARING

Unless otherwise ordered as a result of the filing of any subsequent motion or for other good cause shown, the adjudicatory hearing between the parties will be held on **October 25, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.** at the offices of the Public Employee Labor Relations Board in Concord. The time set aside for this hearing is 4 hours.
