CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE


Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A), and a secret ballot election having been conducted in accordance with RSA 273-A:10 as reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2012-258, it is hereby certified that New England Police Benevolent Association has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

UNIT: All regular Patrol Officers, Master Patrol Officers, Detective Patrol Officers, Youth Services Officers, Regular (full time) Dispatchers, Secretaries and Clerk Typists.

EXCLUDED: Chief of Police, Lieutenants, Administrative Secretary, Sergeants, Dispatcher and Detective Sergeants

Further, IT IS ORDERED that the above named public employer shall negotiate collectively with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
