Order

On May 17, 2013 the International Union of Public Employees filed a petition for certification seeking to represent a bargaining unit consisting of certain employees of the Town of Barrington. The petition was supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (June 5, 2013). On June 25, 2013 the parties informed the PELRB that they reached an agreement on unit composition and on July 2, 2013 the parties filed a stipulation reflecting that they agree to separate the proposed bargaining unit into two units with the following composition.

Police Department Unit:

Police Lieutenant, Police Sergeant, Police Patrolman, Part Time Police Patrolman, and Police Administrative Assistant.

Excluded:

Police Chief, Fire Chief, Road Agent, Transfer Station Supervisor, Recreation Supervisor, Assistant Recreation Director, Highway Department Administrative Assistant, and Recreation Department Administrative Assistant.

Fire Department and Public Works Department Unit:

Full time Firefighter, Laborer, and Transfer Station Attendant.

Excluded:


Police Chief, Fire Chief, Road Agent, Transfer Station Supervisor, Recreation Supervisor, Assistant Recreation Director, Highway Department Administrative Assistant, and Recreation Department Administrative Assistant.

The undersigned finds that the parties have agreed upon appropriate bargaining units in accordance with RSA 273-A:8 and Pub 302. The Police Department unit is assigned Case No. G-0207-1 and the Fire Department and Public Works Department unit is assigned Case No. G-0208-1:

Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on May 17, 2013 and duly posted by the employer, petitions to intervene were due no later than June 3, 2013. No petitions to intervene have been filed. Accordingly, a separate election shall be conducted for each bargaining unit; Orders for Election shall issue forthwith; and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled pursuant to Pub 303.02.
