CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE AND ORDER TO NEGOTIATE

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and a secret ballot election having been conducted in accordance with RSA 273-A:10, as reflected in PELRB Decision No. 2013-190 2013-248, it is hereby certified that the New England Police Benevolent Association has been designated and selected by a majority of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, as their representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.


**Unit:** Corporal, Deputy (full time), Deputy (part time), Dispatcher, Investigator and Clerical/Support Staff

**Exclusions:** Sheriff, Chief Deputy, Captain, Lieutenant, Sergeant, Dispatch Supervisor, Administrative Assistant and On Call/Per diem Deputies.

Further, it is ordered that the above named public employer shall negotiate with the exclusive representative named herein on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of such exclusive representative to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
