Order

On December 5, 2014 the UNH Lecturers United – AAUP filed a Petition for Certification seeking to represent a proposed bargaining unit comprised of UNH Durham and Manchester Lecturers. The petition was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the December 10, 2013 Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. Pursuant to the PELRB Notice of Filing, issued on December 5, 2013 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than December 20, 2013.


The parties have now reached the following agreement as to unit description, as reflected in their January 7, 2014 Stipulation filed with the PELRB:

Unit: All contracted non-tenure track faculty who are appointed as and hold the title of “Lecturer” whose primary responsibility is teaching at UNH’s Durham and/or Manchester campuses. Excluded: Adjuncts and Visiting Faculty.

The January 7, 2014 Stipulation is approved, and the petition is amended to include the January 7, 2014 stipulated unit description and the University’s agreement to the petition as amended.

There otherwise are no exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene on file. In accordance with the provisions of RSA 273-A and N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 300 the petition is granted. An Order of Election shall issue.
