
Supplemental Pre-Hearing Order

The earlier pre-hearing order (Decision 2014-127) approved the parties' request to submit this case for decision on stipulated facts, joint exhibits, and briefs. After the filing of opening briefs and joint stipulations and exhibits the parties requested a conference call with the PELRB, scheduled and held by the undersigned on June 23, 2014. Based upon the information provided during this call it is apparent that the parties need additional time to establish the stipulated record for decision. There is also a possibility that they may be unable to reach necessary stipulations in which event this case will be placed back on the hearing calendar. Accordingly, on or before July 3, 2014 the parties shall complete their efforts to establish the stipulated record for decision. Specific facts or exhibits should not be excluded from the stipulation on relevancy grounds, and either side shall preserve any relevancy objections by an appropriate filing or notation on the stipulations. Such relevancy objections will be addressed to the extent necessary in the decision on the merits of the complaint. The July 3, 2014 date for reply briefs still applies. In the event the parties are unable to agree on a stipulated record for decision by July 3, 2014 they shall so inform the PELRB, a notice of hearing will issue, and any further briefs will be filed pursuant to a schedule to be determined.
