Order

On October 24, 2014 the Claremont Administrators' Association (Association) filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent an agreed upon proposed bargaining unit consisting of the following positions within the Claremont School District (District).

**Unit:** Principal, Assistant Principal, Student Services Coordinator, and Director.

Based on employee list, submitted by the District on November 20, 2014, the petition was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the November 20, 2014 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. Pursuant to the Notice of Filing, issued on October 24, 2014 and duly posted by the employer, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than November 10, 2014. No objections, exceptions or petitions to intervene have been filed.

Per RSA 273-A and N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 300, the petition for secret ballot election is granted and the proposed bargaining unit is approved. An Order for Election shall issue forthwith and a pre-election conference shall be scheduled in accordance with Pub 303.02.
