
On December 2, 2014 the National Correctional Employees Union (NCEU) filed a Petition for Certification – Challenge to Existing Representative seeking a representation election to determine the exclusive representative of certain County employees now represented by AFSCME Local 3657 in the following bargaining unit:

Unit: All-full time employees and regular permanent part-time employees in the following classifications: Account Clerk I, Clerk Typist I, Secretary I, Correctional Officer I, Cook I, Nurse I, Maintenance Worker I, Switchboard Operator/Receptionist.¹

The PELRB issued a Notice of Filing on December 2, 2014 which the County duly posted but no exceptions or objections have been filed. The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards as per the December 15, 2014 Report Re: Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10,V to determine the exclusive representative of the bargaining unit, if any. Both the NCEU and the AFSCME Local 3657 will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order of Election will issue, and a pre-election conference will be scheduled.
