

Order

On January 22, 2015 the PELRB conducted a secret ballot election to resolve a question of representation among certain employees of the Hillsborough County Department of Corrections pursuant to prior PELRB Decision No. 2014-282 (December 31, 2014). As stated in the January 22, 2015 Report of Election and Tally of Ballots, a majority of the eligible employees who voted selected the incumbent, AFSCME Local 3657, Hillsborough County Department of Corrections Employees as their exclusive representative. There have not been any challenges or objections filed under N.H. Admin. Rules, Pub 303, and the time for the filing of any motions under N.H. Admin. Rules, Pub 205, has passed. Accordingly, the existing unit certification order remains in full force and effect.
