Order

On June 20, 2018, the Teamsters Local 633 (Teamsters) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit comprised of certain employees of the Town of Seabrook currently represented by the Seabrook Employees' Association, SEIU Local 1984 (SEA). See PELRB Decision No. 2008-252 (December 10, 2008). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report Re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (June 28, 2018).

The subject bargaining unit contains the following Town of Goffstown positions:


Unit: Assessing Clerk-Certified, Bookkeeper, Chief Mechanic, Clerk, Custodian, Custodian-CDL, Dispatcher, Equipment Operator/Laborer, Equipment Operator/Laborer-CDL, Janitor, Laborer, Laborer-CDL, Mechanic I-CDL, Payroll and Benefits Supervisor, Recreation Office Supervisor, Scale House Operator, Secretary, Solid Waste Operator-CDL, Solid Waste Foreman, Wastewater Laboratory Technician, Wastewater Pre-Treatment Manager, Wastewater Operator-Grade I, Wastewater Operator-Grade I-CDL, Wastewater Operator-Grade II-CDL, Wastewater Operator-Grade III-CDL, Water Operator-Grade I, Water Operator-Grade I-CDL, Water Operator-Grade II-CDL, Water Operator-Grade III-CDL, Working Foreman, Working Foreman-CDL.

See PELRB Decision No. 2008-252. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

The Teamsters' request for an election to resolve the question of representation is granted. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit, if any. "Teamsters Local 633," "Seabrook Employees' Association, SEIU Local 1984," and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall be issued and a pre-election conference shall be conducted in accordance with Pub 303.02.
