**Order**

On August 24, 2018, the Teamsters Local 633 (Union) filed an election petition for certification seeking to represent certain employees of the Town of Hooksett Department of Public Works (Town). The petition for certification was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the September 6, 2018 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. No exceptions, objections or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

On September 11, 2018, the parties have submitted an agreed upon modified petition for certification reflecting their agreement on the composition of the proposed bargaining unit. Based upon the September 11, 2018 filing, the parties agree to the following proposed unit composition:

**Unit:** All full time and regular part time drivers/laborers, laborers, drivers, transfer station employees, heavy equipment operators/laborers, heavy equipment operators/drivers, mechanics/technicians, and assistant crew chiefs.


**Excluded:** All Town managerial staff, master mechanics, crew chiefs, and administrative assistant.

The bargaining unit proposed by the parties is approved. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. "Teamsters Local 633" and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Pub 303.02.
