Order

On September 20, 2018, the AFSCME, Council 93, Local 3657, AFL-CIO (AFSCME) filed a challenge petition requesting an election to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit comprised of certain employees of the Town of Hanover Police Department represented by the NEPBA Local 27, IUPA, AFL-CIO, Hanover Police Union (NEPBA). See PELRB Decision No. 2007-002 (January 5, 2007). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report Re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (October 4, 2018).

The subject bargaining unit contains the following Hanover Police Department positions:

Unit: Detective, Police Officer, Records Coordinator, Communications Officer, Parking/Control/Facility Technician, Parking Control Officer, Parking Facility Cashier, and Administrative Clerk.

Excluded: Police Chief, Captain, Lieutenant, and Sergeant.

See PELRB Decision No. 2007-002 (January 5, 2007). No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

The AFSCME's request for an election to resolve the question of representation is granted. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit, if any. "AFSCME, Council 93, Local 3657, AFL-CIO," "NEPBA Local 27, IUPA, AFL-CIO, Hanover Police Union," and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election conference shall be conducted in accordance with Pub 303.02.
