Order

On December 28, 2018, the New England Police Benevolent Association (NEPBA) filed a challenge petition requesting a representation election for an existing bargaining unit comprised of the following Hillsborough County Attorney's Office (HCAO) employees:

Unit:

Secretarial positions, Clerical positions and Professional positions including

Victim/Attorney Advocates and the Paralegal position

Excluded:

County Attorney, Legal Interns, Drug Prosecutor, Domestic Violence Attorney,

Attorneys, Victim/Witness Director & Office Manager.

See PELRB Decision No. 2003-061 (June 19, 2003). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report Re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (January 11, 2019). No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed. The NEPBA's request for a representation election is approved, and this case will proceed to election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10. "New England Police Benevolent Association," "HCAO, Teamsters Local 633," and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An order of election shall issue, and a pre-election conference will be scheduled.
