Order

On April 24, 2019, the City of Nashua Police Commission filed an agreed upon petition for modification pursuant to N.H. Admin. Rule Pub 302.05 seeking to update the description of the existing bargaining unit set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2018-146 (September 5, 2018). The parties also jointly requested a removal of the positions of Parking Enforcement Specialist, Network Administrator, and Records Supervisor from the list of positions excluded from the bargaining unit stating that these positions no longer exist. Pursuant to the April 24, 2019 PELRB Notice of Filing, exceptions, objections, and petitions to intervene were due no later than May 9, 2019. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case. The petition for modification is hereby granted. Accordingly, a unit modification order shall issue forthwith.
