Order

On August 2, 2019, the Londonderry Police Employees Association (LPEA) filed a Petition for Certification – Challenge to Existing Representative seeking to represent a Londonderry Police Department bargaining unit currently represented by the AFSCME Local 3657. See Decision No. 2015-220 (September 28, 2015). The petition is supported by the requisite number of authorization cards. See PELRB Report Re Confidential Inspection of Authorization Cards (August 5, 2019).

The proposed bargaining unit contains the following Londonderry Police Department positions:

Unit:

All regular permanent Londonderry Police Department employees, including Patrolmen, Sergeants, Dispatchers, Juvenile Officers, Dispatcher/Records Clerk, Dispatch Supervisor, Detectives, Records Supervisor, Prosecutor, Sergeant/Technician, Safety Officers, Animal Control Officer, Assistant Animal Control Officers, and part time Records Clerk...

See Decision No. 2015-220 (September 28, 2015). No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case.

The LPEA's request for an election to resolve the question of representation is granted. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the existing bargaining unit, if any. "Londonderry Police Employees Association," "AFSCME Local 3657," and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election conference shall be conducted in accordance with Pub 303.02.
