Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of an RSA 273-A:10 secret ballot election (see PELRB Decision No. 2019-246), it is hereby certified that the AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer in the unit described below for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

Unit: Asst. Planner, Engineering Asst., Chief Chemist, Asst. Fire Chief, Public Health Nurse, Bldg. Inspector, Children's Librarian, Foreman, Shop Foreman, Sewer Foreman, Assessor/Clerk, Clerk, Receptionist/Typist, Account Clerk/Secretary, Secretary, Secretary/Clerk, Administrative Clerk and Desk Assistant, and Assessing Coordinator/Deputy City Clerk.

The City of Berlin shall negotiate with the AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the AFSCME Council 93, AFL-CIO to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
