Order

On October 24, 2019, the Town of Gilford filed an agreed upon petition for modification pursuant to N.H. Admin. R. Pub 302.05 seeking to remove the following positions from the existing bargaining unit set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2015-224 (October 1, 2015): Deputy Director, Operations Manager, Solid Waste Superintendent, Buildings & Grounds Superintendent, Secretary, Clerical Assistant/Receptionist, and all part-time employees. Pursuant to the October 24, 2019 PELRB Notice of Filing, exceptions, objections, and petitions to intervene were due no later than November 8, 2019. No exceptions, objections, or petitions to intervene have been filed in this case. The petition for modification is hereby granted. Accordingly, a unit modification order shall issue forthwith.
