## Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of an RSA 273-A:10 secret ballot election (see PELRB Decision No. 2019-290), it is hereby certified that the New Hampshire Probation and Parole Officers Association is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer in the unit described below for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances.

Unit:

All Probation/Parole Officers I and II employed by the State of New Hampshire, Department of Corrections.

The State of New Hampshire Department of Corrections shall negotiate with the New Hampshire Probation and Parole Officers Association as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the New Hampshire Probation and Parole Officers Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
