Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to RSA 273-A and PELRB Decision No. 2019-301 granting the Union's petition for modification, the existing certification, set forth in PELRB Decision No. 2011-158 (May 27, 2011), is amended; and it is hereby ordered that the composition of the modified bargaining unit, represented by the New England Police Benevolent Association for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances, is as follows:

Unit:

All regular full time Patrol Officers and Dispatchers of the Town of

Hooksett Police Department.

Excluded:

Chief of Police, Captains, Lieutenants, Sergeants, Dispatch Supervisor, Administrative Assistant, Prosecutor, all other supervisors, professional and confidential employees, persons in probationary or temporary status, employed seasonally, irregularly or on call, and all

other employees of the Hooksett Police Department.

The Town of Hooksett shall negotiate with the New England Police Benevolent Association as exclusive representative on the terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit and shall recognize the right of the New England Police Benevolent Association to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
