Background:

This conference was scheduled following the board's prior consolidation order. See PELRB Decision No. 2020-035. After reviewing with the parties the scope of the complaints filed, the legal issues raised, and the fact that there do not appear to be any factual disputes which require an evidentiary hearing, I have determined this case can be submitted for decision on

stipulations, briefs, and affidavits as necessary according to the following schedule established with the agreement of the parties at the conference:

March 13, 2020: Stipulations, Affidavits, Exhibits

March 23, 2020: Briefs

March 26, 2020: Reply Briefs (limit 5 pages).

It is expected that the stipulations will be comprehensive, and affidavits filed only to provide information that a party has refused to include in the stipulations. The parties should address in their briefs any relevancy objection they may have to any stipulation or affidavit, but such an objection is not grounds for refusal to enter a stipulation. The decision will address all such objections as appropriate as necessary.
