**Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate**

Pursuant to PELRB Decision No. 2020-263, the Internal Affairs Association of New Hampshire is now affiliated with the Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire. Accordingly, pursuant to the authority vested in the Board by the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A), the Internal Affairs Association of New Hampshire, affiliated with Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire is the exclusive representative of the employees of the above named public employer, in the unit described below, for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances:

**Unit:** Internal Affairs Investigators I, Internal Affairs Investigators II, Internal Affairs Investigators III, and Internal Affairs Administrative Secretary.

The State of New Hampshire, Department of Corrections shall negotiate with the Internal Affairs Association of New Hampshire, affiliated with Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the Internal Affairs Association of New Hampshire, affiliated with Teamsters Local 633 of New Hampshire to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
