Order

On November 5, 2020, the NEPBA - NH State Law Enforcement Officers' Union (NEPRB) filed a challenge petition for certification¹ seeking to represent Department of Safety employees in the following proposed bargaining unit:

Unit: Fire Investigators and State Office Complex Patrol Officers.

The petition was supported by the requisite number of confidential authorization cards as reflected in the November 23, 2020 PELRB Report re: Inspection of Confidential Authorization Cards. Pursuant to the PELRB November 5, 2020 Notice of Filing, exceptions, objections, and/or petitions to intervene were due no later than November 20, 2020. None were filed, and the State has notified the PELRB that it takes no position on the petition.


Pursuant to RSA 273-A and N.H. Admin. Rules, Pub 300, the petition is granted and the proposed bargaining unit is approved. Accordingly, the PELRB will conduct a secret ballot

election pursuant to RSA 273-A:10 to determine the exclusive representative of the approved unit, if any. "NEPBA - NH State Law Enforcement Officers' Union," "State Employees' Association of NH, SEIU Local 1984," and "No Representative" will appear as choices on the ballot. An Order for Election shall issue and a pre-election conference shall be conducted pursuant to Pub 303.02.
