Certification of Representative and Order to Negotiate

Pursuant to the Public Employee Labor Relations Act (RSA 273-A) and the results of a secret ballot election (see PELRB Decision No. 2021-018), it is hereby certified that the NEPBA, NH State Law Enforcement Supervisors' Union has been designated and selected as the exclusive representative for purposes of collective negotiations and settlement of grievances of the following bargaining unit:

Unit:

Deputy Fire Marshall I and II who are sworn law enforcement officers, Liquor Division of Enforcement Lieutenant, State Office Complex Lieutenant, and

State Office Complex Sergeant.

Excluded: All other Department of Safety and Liquor Commission positions.

The State of New Hampshire, Department of Safety and Liquor Commission, shall negotiate with the NEPBA, NH State Law Enforcement Supervisors' Union as exclusive representative on terms and conditions of employment for the members of the bargaining unit, as herein described, and shall recognize the right of the NEPBA, NH State Law Enforcement Supervisors' Union to represent employees in the settlement of grievances.
